



Due to the COVID-19 Coronavirus, the Church of the Good Shepherd requests that you follow these guidelines in accordance with church policy that is based on guidance provided by federal (CDC) and state (NHDHS) health officials and the Diocese of New Hampshire.

- Kindly make an appointment before visiting the church office or facility.
- Stay at home if you are sick, and self-quarantine if you think you may have been exposed to someone with COVID-19.
- Wash your hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer, especially after touching frequently used items or surfaces.
- You are required to wear a face mask, without vents, at all times while on church property. Children under 2 and those who are unable to remove a mask on their own should not wear face coverings.
- Please limit your visit to the office area unless given prior approval.
- During your visit, please practice physical distancing, at least 6 feet (1.8 meters) apart.
- Disinfect frequently used items and surfaces.
- Dispose of used sanitizing materials and masks in a trash receptacle.
- If you feel ill or are concerned that you may have contracted COVID-19 after visiting the church building, please contact the church immediately. You may remain anonymous, just let us know what date/time you visited, whom you may have come in contact with, and what areas of the building you visited.

- Except for the accessible seating and hearing-assistance pews, please fill pews from the front of the church to the back.
- Kindly follow posted traffic flow to assist with physical distancing while entering and exiting the church.
- If you feel ill or are concerned you may have contracted COVID-19 after visiting the church building, please contact the church immediately. You may remain anonymous, just let us know what date/time you visited, whom you might have come in contact with, and what areas of the building you visited.

Unfortunately, at this time we will not be able to engage in a physical exchanging of the peace, singing, or sharing in communion. BCPs and hymnals can be vectors for COVID spread if shared. Please bring your own or make arrangements with the church office to borrow a set during the time they are not available in the church.

- When attending private prayer, kindly adhere to your time slot.
- You are required to wear a face mask, without vents, at all times while on church property.
- Please begin seating from the front of the church, leaving the front left pew open for accessible seating and the hearing-assistance pew open for congregants who need assistance.
- To maintain physical distancing, please do not sit in blocked-off pews.
- A family, defined as members of a single household, will be seated together.
- Within each pew, parties should remain separated by 6 feet (1.8 meters).
- Please remain in your seat throughout the service.
- Unfortunately, at this time we will not be able to engage in a physical exchanging of the peace, singing, or sharing in communion.
- At the conclusion of the service, please exit the church starting from the back. Please remain in your pew until those behind you have exited the building.
- Upon dismissal, please do not congregate on the front lawn or sidewalks. Please maintain physical distancing.

Restrooms will be available for urgent needs. If you must use the restroom, sanitization supplies will be available. We will not have staff available to sanitize the restrooms after each user.

- At the conclusion of the service, please exit the church property starting from the back. Please remain in your space until the people in the spaces behind you have exited the area.
- Upon dismissal, please do not congregate on the front lawn or sidewalks. Please maintain physical distancing, at least 6 feet (1.8 meters) from those outside your family unit.

Restrooms will be available for urgent needs. If you must use the restroom, sanitization supplies will be available. We will not have staff available to sanitize the restrooms after each user.

- QUARANTINE for 14 days if you have:
 - traveled domestically outside of NH, MA, ME, CT, RI, VT*
 - been on a cruise ship
 - used public transportation
 - traveled internationally
