

## **Vestry Meeting on Covid-19 Pandemic**

**April 7, 2020**

### **Meeting held via Zoom Video Conferencing**

The meeting began online at 7:05PM.

Pastor Mike began with some updates within our parish. The Huntington now has 9 positive cases of Covid-19, 3 of which are parishioners. He also mentioned that another parishioner had passed away, not from Covid-19. Pastor Mike was allowed, (with full protection), to enter and give Last Rites, following that he was asked to visit some other patients for blessings.

Calls: Time to call back folks in need, anyone who is isolated. Pastor Mike wants names of those who need a call from him.

Financial: Laurie has begun the process of applying for the CARES Act assistance. This loan will provide for payroll assistance as well as some additional funding for basic needs such as maintenance. On July 1, as long as our payroll has not changed, the loan will be forgiven in full.

The minutes from the March Vestry meeting as well as the March 14 Emergency Meeting were approved unanimously.

Curate Search Update: Two final candidates were identified before the virus shutdown when Pastor Mike's visits to seminaries were cancelled. They are on hold and awaiting disposition. Much is up in the air at this time, including the ability for candidates to be ordained. Mike would like to visit more seminaries before presenting a list of candidates to the Bishop.

Maundy Thursday meals are to be delivered to the church on Thursday for distribution. Many people volunteered to help with deliveries. A schedule will be forthcoming.
